For the 6 months ended 30 June 2008, the Company reported a net loss after tax of \$\$0.61 million compared to a net profit after tax of \$\$80.39 million for the 6 months ended 30 June 2007. The net loss after tax for the 6 months ended 30 June 2008 of \$\$0.61 million resulted from total investment income of \$\$1.48 million and operating expenses of \$\$2.09 million. The components of the investment expense for the 6 months ended 30 June 2008 is explained below.

For the 6 months ended 30 June 2007, the Company reported net profit after tax of S\$80.39 million that resulted from investment income of S\$132.43 million offset by operating expenses of S\$33.78 million (including performance incentive fees on the Company's rise in NAV subsequent to 31 December 2006) and income tax expense of S\$18.26 million. Investment income for the 6 months ended 30 June 2007 consisted of net gains from investments of S\$110.82 million; dividend income of S\$19.98 million and interest income of S\$1.63 million.

Investment income / (expense) review for the 6 months ended 30 June 2008:

Total investment income of S\$1.48 million for the 6 months ended 30 June 2008 consisted of:

- net gains from investments of S\$1.27 million (described below);
- interest income of S\$0.17 million; and
- dividends of S\$0.04 million from quoted investments received from Hang Fung Gold Technology Limited.

The net gains from investments of S\$1.27 million resulted from:

- a net loss on disposal of quoted and unquoted investments of S\$0.03 million that comprises:
 - o S\$1.06 million and S\$0.01 million gains from divestments of Hang Fung Gold Technology Limited and Thai Stainless Steel Co., Ltd respectively; and
 - S\$1.10 million loss from divestment of P.T. Bukaka Teknik Utama before consideration of the reversal of impairment loss.
- a net favorable change of S\$0.19 million in the fair value of the covered call options granted to UBS AG relating to shares held in Hsu Fu Chi International Limited.
- a write back of the impairment loss of S\$1.11 million previously recognised on disposal of P.T. Bukaka Teknik Utama.
- (b) The Company's net asset value for the 6 months ended 30 June 2008 decreased to \$\$246.94 million from \$\$263.39 million as of 31 December 2007 as a result of the loss for the period of \$\$0.61 million (detailed above) and a decrease in fair value reserve for available-for-sale investments of \$\$15.84 million. The decrease in the fair value reserve resulted primarily from the decline in market value of listed shares (mainly Neo-Neon Holdings Limited) held in the portfolio as well as the sale of certain investments.
